

Grab some stickers (any type will work great!)



Let your kids put as many stickers on each other as want OR set a timer and see how many they can stick on each other in 30 seconds.

When they are done, tell them they can now put all the stickers on their parents...but they have to say something they are thankful for with each sticker they place on mom or dad

**PRESCHOOL
ACTIVITY**

Grab some jenga blocks or any blocks that you can find

Build a tower together. This tower represents our own kingdom that we have built for ourselves. When we rely on our own strength, desires, and abilities, we can do things that are displeasing to God and keep us from following him closely. Take turns pulling a block from the tower while naming something that could keep you from following God closely.

Once the tower has fallen, begin to rebuild it together. Each time you place a block, name something that helps you follow Jesus closely. When the tower is built, say a quick prayer together thanking Jesus for giving us everything we need to follow him. Ask him to help you remove anything from your life that draws your attention away from him.
